- Class 1: Trot poles. Rosettes to clear rounds. May be led/assisted. Max 8 fences
- Class 2: Junior Trot poles. Rosettes to clear rounds. May be led/assisted. Max 8 fences
- Class 3: Beginners. Approx. height 45cm. Rosettes to clear rounds. Max 8 fences
- Class 4: Junior Beginners Approx. height 45cm. Rosettes to clear rounds. Max 8 fences
- Class 5: Minimus. Approx. height 50-55cm.
- Class 6: Junior Minimus. Approx. height 50-55cm.
- Class 7: Nursery Novice. Approx. height 60-65cm.
- Class 8: Junior Nursery Novice. Approx. Height 60-65cm.
- Class 9: Novice. Approx. height 70-75.
- Class 10: Junior Novice. Approx. height 70-75cm.
- Class 11: Intermediate. Approx. height 80-85cm. Ron Wheelans Trophy to highest placed FRC member
- Class 12: Junior Intermediate. Approx. height 80-85cm.
- Class 13: Small Open. Approx. height 90-95cm. K & L Packer Trophy to highest placed FRC member
- Class 14: Junior Small Open. Approx. height 90-95cm.
- Class 15: Open**. Approx. height 100-105cm first round. Granny Balfour Trophy to highest placed FRC member.

"Junior" = riders under 16 years; Rosettes to 6^{th} in classes 3 - 15.

Classes will be Single Phase. With the exception of Classes 1 – 4 & 15, the first part of the course will be jumped in the usual way; the second part of the course will be timed. In the event of equality of points, the time will determine placings. **** Class 15 Open** will run over two rounds with double clears (if any) going into final timed jump off.

ENTRY FEE – FRC Members* – £8; Non-Members – £10

FRC Members are paid up full Riding, Associate or Honorary members as at the date of entry

All classes MUST be pre-entered via clubentries.com.

GENERAL RULES

Dress Code: Show Jackets with shirt & tie/stock/show shirt with jodhpurs/breeches and long riding boots or short boots with matching gaiters. In hot weather jackets may be removed but only with the judge's permission. Short sleeved shirts are ok but not sleeveless. Safety Hats complying to BRC Rules must be worn at all times when mounted. Back Protectors are recommended for jumping classes. Details of hat and back protector standards are available on the Fife RC website.

Tack & Equipment: Padded whips are now mandatory in jumping classes at BRC meetings and whips must only be used as per Rules. Details of how to use whips are available on the Fife RC website.

It is a condition of entry that all competitors agree to abide by the above rules

Handling and Riding horses is inherently risky. All competitors take part at own risk. Whilst BRC members are insured at BRC-organised shows, Non-Members are NOT insured and should arrange their own Public Liability and Personal Accident Insurance e.g. BHS Gold Membership. Everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure health, safety and welfare of those attending the event but ultimately, everyone is responsible for their own Health & Safety and for that of all other field users.
